

Battery Operated Smoke Detector



Features

Every home should be protected by a smoke detector. On detecting smoke, our smoke detectors will sound an audible alarm. They will then communicate with the INS LifeGuard Emergency Unit, which will transmit a signal to our Emergency Response Centre so appropriate action can be taken.

Our 9V Smoke Detector is photoelectric, resets automatically on the detector, and has sensitivity set to suit Australian Standards. When the battery runs low, the detector will chirp intermittently for up to 30 days to alert the user. Designed and manufactured in Australia, it has a 2-year limited warranty (conditions apply).

Specifications

- Available in 304MHz or 433MHz, depending on base unit — compatible with INS supplied equipment only
- Alarm transmits wirelessly, no interlink required between detector and base unit
- Red LED flashes at 45 second intervals to indicate detector is operational
- Alarm signal is via internal sounder (85 dBA), fast flashing LED, and the LifeGuard unit
- Battery requires replacement once a year, unless depleted sooner
- Dimensions: 113mm x 76mm
- Weight: 157 grams
- Colour: off-white
